Intellectual property rights (IPR) have become front-page news. Students are being served restraining orders for reverse-engineering campus networks, Internet users are being sued for swapping files, and professors fear to publish their research. Meanwhile trade groups argue that free information exchange profoundly threatens the film, music, and software industries.
